




Guide for accessing padlet

Step 1: Type the URL **https://tinyurl.com/smpshblday** onto Google Chrome address bar.

Step 2: Read the instruction given on the webpage

Step 1: Click on the page that shows Chinese Language.
Step 2: Find your level.
Step 3: Use the Padlet to ask questions according to the class that you attend your Chinese Language lessons.


For Malay and Tamil Language related questions, follow the steps below:-
Step 1: Click on the page that shows Malay / Tamil Language.
Step 2: Find your Malay / Tamil Language Teacher's name.
Step 3: Use the Padlet to ask questions.

For Questions related to English, Maths and Science.


- ▶ Step 3: Click on the page that shows your level.

Posting Questions


- ▶ Step 5: Use the Padlet to ask questions according to the subject listed on the Padlet



Step 7: Type your name in the title
Type your question

Step 6: Press the + sign.

Step 8: Click on any empty space on the padlet to post the question



Selecting Level & Class

For Questions related to MT,

- ▶ Step 9: click on the MT that you are taking
- ▶ Step 10: For students taking Chinese Language, choose the classroom that you are using for Chinese lessons. For ML and TL, choose the teacher that are teaching you and you can start to post (repeat step 6-8) .
